This is a two-part permission form. Employees who wish to bring their dogs to their offices during working hours must: 1) complete Part 1 of the form, ask their department chair or supervisor to sign it, and, then, 2) fill out Part II, and email a scanned copy of both pages of the form, along with a copy of their dog's town license information as well as a digital photograph of their dog, to the Department of Public Safety at publicsafety@middlebury.edu (please write "Dog Registration" in the subject line). Department chair or supervisor approval does not guarantee final approval of dog registration. Final approval is granted by the Office of the General Counsel once it has been determined that the registration adheres to the "Dogs at Work" policy. Once the dog registration has received final approval, a packet with a sign will be sent in campus mail with further instructions.
